As you are aware, the captioned matters were listed on 29.03.2023 before HMJ Tarun Shridhar and HMJ Pratima K. Gupta before Bench-V of the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal.

I was instructed to appear on behalf of the Petitioners in the captioned matters.

When the matter was called out, I submitted to the court that the matter pertains to revision of the pension benefits of the retired employees of Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited ("BSNL") and Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited ("MTNL"), absorbed from Department of Telecommunications. At the time of absorption, the employees were specifically assured that they shall be treated on par with the government pensioners. However, despite the implementation of the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission and 3d pay revision, the pension of the Applicants remains unaffected.

At this juncture, the counsel for the Respondent No. 2 in O.A. 1272/2020 submitted that an application is pending before this Hon'ble Tribunal for its deletion from the array of parties, as MTNL is not responsible for payment of pension of the Applicants. I submitted to the court that a similar application was filed by BSNL in O.A. 1271/2020 for its deletion, and has been



considered by this Hon'ble Tribunal on 09.08.2021, and the court had observed that the application shall be heard along with the main OA.

The court enquired as to who is currently remitting the pension of the Applicants. I submitted that currently, the Department of Telecommunications is paying the same. The court enquired about the counsel for Union of India, who was not present in court. The proxy for the counsel for the Union of India submitted that the senior standing counsel is in difficulty, and therefore, not available.

In light of the above, the court observed that due to unavailability of the counsel for Respondents, it shall hear the matter on the next date, and was pleased to renotify the matter on 19.05.2023 as a part-heard matter.
