Decisions of ONLINE Meeting of National Executive of NCCPA on 10.11.2025

The Online Meeting of National Executive of NCCPA was held on 10.11.2025 at 3.00 P.M and the President Comrade Shiva Gopal Mishra has presided the meeting of NCCPA NE.

31 of the Office Bearers and representatives of Affiliates have participated. At the outset the President has informed in his speech that there is heavy disappointment among pensioners as there was not a mention about them in the terms of references of 8th CPC announced by the Government. Earlier I have told the Official Side about the terms of reference and the Official Side had also told that there will be no difference between the 7th and 8th CPC. No meeting has been fixed yet by the Government side and I hope that something will come up in those meetings and I will surely explain in that meeting. And in my capacity as the JCM Staff Side Secretary I have convened a staff side internal meeting to go ahead with the preparation of CPC and the output of Pensioners Unions and NCCPA also will be very helpful. I will stand with the Pensioners.

Then the President called upon the Secretary General to explain the Agenda of the Meeting. The Secretary General explained the agenda for the meeting. He stated that some Associations Viz., Damodar Valley Corporation Pensioners Association; Kolkata Retired Central Bank Employees Welfare Association and Pensioners Welfare Association of College Teachers of Haryana also applied for affiliation with NCCPA and therefore the agenda Number 5 to be added those names of associations as No.E,F and G. Both the President and the Patron said at that point that Agenda No.5 can be taken up in the next meeting after all the applications for affiliation with NCCPA are circulated among the Affiliates and Office Bearers and their opinion on the affiliation is collected and placed for the final opinion of the national executive of NCCPA. The Secretary General accordingly informed the house that he will inform all concerned in email about the applications received by him and collect the opinions and place in the next National Executive Meeting of NCCPA for a final opinion on those applications. He explained the other agenda items.

Discussion started on the items 1 and 4, Viz., the “Review of Forum of Civil Pensioners Associations call to combine legal and Organizational Agitations including Delhi Chalo on 10.10.2025” and the item of ” Central Cabinet’s decision as per Gazette Notification dated 03.11.2025 for 8 th CPC and the reaction of the NCCPA”.

The Decision is as follows after all the Associations Chief Executives and Representatives as well as many Office Bearers spoke:

“The struggle for inclusion of Pension Revision of past Pensioners in the 8th CPC in the terms of reference by the organizational forms by us as well as the Negotiations should continue. The Negotiations with the Government will be undertaken by the President in his capacity as the JCM Staff Side Secretary and the struggle forms will be democratically decided in the 13th November 2025 Forum of Civil Pensioners online Meeting after suggesting from NCCPA that it will be better to consider the “All Associations in FCPA writing to the Prime Minister on the demands of the Pensioners and the disappointment due to the terms of reference; Postcard campaign to involve every Pensioner and Family Pensioner; Topless demonstrations by the Pensioners in the districts; Regional level conventions regions by all Circle Associations for mobilizing the Pensioners; Circle level action of Organising Central TUs and all Employees Unions; Circle level action of Organizing all India alliance Political Parties to the Forum on 13.11.2025. Individual Organizations are free to suggest any other Programmes in the Forum Meeting on 13th November. Efforts should be taken to struggle and build

pensioners -employees unity and involvement through the Forum and the JCM Staff Side.


The Agenda No.2 and 3 are then taken into for discussion.

The Secretary General explained the agenda items 2 and 3 Viz., “Filing of Supreme Court Case by 19 Federations and Associations in the NCCPA and Non-NCCPA (Forum) against validation clause and the Present Position” and the item of “Review of Affiliates Contribution to FCPA legal Fund and NCCPA Speical Fund”.The NCCPA Treasurer Comrade G.Kumar also explained the names of some Associations who kept the dues. The following decision was taken.

“ The decision of the Supreme Court will be known about the case as intimated by the Advocate on the validation case filed by 19 Associations signed in the Affidvit. The names of Associations and Federations which have balance to remit will be told in the Forum Meeting to expedite the legal fund collection.”

The meeting ended with the formal vote of thanks of the SG.
